Koralpe is a ski resort located in Austria's most eastern mountain range. Koralpe is described as "a mountain for all seasons" offering skiing in safe, uncrowded slopes in winter and beautiful unspoilt surroundings for summer activities.

Winter & Skiing

Koralpe Village lies at an altitude of 1550m to 2070m and there are nearly 30km of well-groomed ski runs, ranging from nursery slopes to carving runs up to 100m wide. The perfectly groomed slopes comprise 13km of blue, 13km red and 3km of black runs; there are also 60 km of cross-country ski trails. The best thing about Koralpe is that it has the feel of a private ski resort and it is extremely family friendly so you the children can roam freely in the mountains without getting lost! The slopes also have newly installed snow-making facilities to ensure good snow conditions all winter long, and are serviced by a 5 ski lifts which can comfortably handle up to 10,000 skiers per hour so there are never any queues or crowds. Other activities available include a 3km sledding run, snow-shoeing, curling and winter paragliding.
